Testator: **Mary Jordan** of Burford, Oxon, widow

To Nephew **James Leg** - £40

To Nephews **Nicholas Eve, Russell Eve, Thomas Eve** and **John Eve** - £7

To Nieces **Mary Eve** and **Susannah Eve** - £7

To Grand-daughter **Elizabeth Beazley** - Bedstead, green curtains, Chest of Draws & a plain Gold Ring

To Grand-Daughter **Mary Beazley** - stitched fringed quilt

To Daughter **Beazley** her Husband's large Picture, release of debts & a mourning gown of value in excess of 1 Guinea

Desires burial in the Silvester Isle in Burford Church, next to her husband and with a memorial stone

Residue to her Nephew **Thomas Leg**

Executor: **Thomas Leg**

Witnessed : **D. Lea, Mary Bartholomew, J. Rogers**

Signed – 18 Nov 1751
