Summary

Richard Jordan of Witney, Oxon, Gent

To son **John Jordan**

- The George Inn, on the west of the High Street in Burford, Oxon and in the occupation of **Tho Kemmett**
- Property in Witney, comprising
 - The testators dwelling house
 - Two properties adjoining the dwelling house in occupation or tenure of **Reginald Smith & Robert Heydon**
 - The Corporation Hall that adjoins the dwelling house
 - The Closes, Barnes, Stables, Malthouses, Outhouses, Backsides, Orchards, Gardens Ways, Waters, Pasem* & Commons attached to the preceding properties

On condition that he pay the testator's daughter **Mary Kible** £10 per year (payment regime stated).

Unto late Servant **Frances Wiggins** 40/-

Unto poor of Witney three pounds

All the rest of Goods & Chattels to son **John Jordan**

Executor: his son John Jordan

Witnessed: **John Constable, W^m Bird, Hannah Gadfield**

Signed – 4 Apr 1719

Proved - 21 Jul 1721 by John Jordan the son
