Son John 30 to my **son B** 30 **da Loder** 30 **A Asgill** 30 **J Wibbenton** 30 **H ... Jordan** 30 my **d Loder** my silver Tankard my **d Asgill** my silver Salver my **d Wibbenton** my silver plate my datt my porringer **H Jordan** every one of my Grandchildren a broad piece except **Charles** 5 pound and to my 4 daughters my Lin[en] amongst them and to **Hannah** my wrought Green bed and bedding with all that belongs to it and to **Molle Loder** my red bed and bedding with all that belongs to it and to **Hannah** all my China and Delph and to my 2 maids 20 shillings.. apiece and to **Bens Wife** my teaspoons and a proad piece **Son Willerton [or Wibbenton]** a broad piece my **Cosin Reanes [or Heanes]** a broad piece and the poor 6 pound and **old John Colburn** 20 Shillings **Cosin Loggan and Wife** a Guinea apiece **C Whitall and Wife** a Guinea apiece **Mary Hart** and **Emblem Huse** a Guinea apiece they are my God daughters my desire is that my **son John** and my **daughter Loder**

may be my Executors of this my Will.

Thomas Cock of Burford in the County of Oxon Sadler
and **Catherine Osmond the wife of John Osmond of Burford aforesaid Taylor**
jointly and severally make oath that these *opo*ts were well acquainted
with the Character and handwriting of **Mrs Ursula Jordan late of Burford**
aforesaid Widow deceased the Relict of John Jordan late of Burford aforesaid
Gent deceased...[Etc verifying the writing in this will]

Probate granted to **Johannis Jordan** and **Ursulae Loder**
